Coach Gargaro and his staff have been running fundamental skills camps for boys and girls for over 20 years. Their interest in teaching and developing basic fundamental basketball skills is well known. Again this year there will also be an additional camp focusing solely on shooting fundamentals and offensive skills.

All proceeds will go to St. Croix Catholic School athletics. We will be accepting Approximately 40 participants for each session. (The camp is always more fun for the kids, when they know they have a friend who is also participating. The camp is not limited to SCCS students, everyone is welcome)

The camp for grades 1 through 6 offers an opportunity for younger players to learn and improve basic basketball skills. Each day we will exercise proper shooting form, ball handling, passing, defensive skills, game situations and the rules of the game.

The shooting and offensive skills camp will focus on teaching the players the proper shooting fundamentals and offensive skills for their age and ability. This will include instruction for players at all positions (guard/forward and center).
