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**SJHS Sports Info for
SCCS 7th & 8th grade students**

July 9, 2010

Dear Parents:

This year, our 7th and 8th grade Middle School students will once again have the opportunity to participate in some of the after school sports offered at Stillwater Junior High School. Because of the difference in dismissal times at SCCS and Stillwater Junior High School (3:35 at SCCS and 2:30 at SJHS), students registering for these sports will be allowed to leave SCCS at 2:30 pm on practice or meet days. Students will be missing most of their last class of the day and their end of the day SuCCesS time.

Those students participating in Junior High sports will go on an Independent Study Contract for the class they miss until their sport is finished for the season. The teachers will try to assist each student, but it will be the parent who is responsible for teaching the student the assigned course work. Weekly communication, initiated by the parent, between home and school will be required to maintain the student's focus and success. The student and parent will also be responsible to give a copy of the meet/game schedule with early dismissals to the SCCS office after the first day of practice.

Transportation to the Junior High School **will not** be provided. Rides and carpooling would be the best option to lessen the amount of class time missed. (A release form must be signed if you want your child to walk to SJHS.)

Early dismissal from SCCS will be allowed only for sports not available to students through CAA (Catholic Athletic Association) or VAA (Valley Athletic Association). As a part of our agreement with District 834, students should register for most Stillwater Junior High School sports **at SCCS**. Your check will be made out to SCCS and we will in turn pay Stillwater Junior High School. The cost of these sports for SCCS students is higher than for SJHS students. This is because our students are required to pay the actual cost of the sport. **The exception to registering at SCCS is those students registering for football – they are asked to register on August 12 or 13 between 1 and 3 pm at Stillwater Junior High School.**

To register for:

7th or 8th grade football

- Turn in registration at Stillwater Junior High School on August 12 or 13 between 1 – 3 pm.
- Forms required at registration are “Parent Permit Form” and the fee.
- To register you must have a 7th grade physical on file at SCCS. Please tell the person taking your registration that you are from SCCS.
- Once you have registered you should complete an Independent Study Contract for the class you will be missing and a Walking Release Form and bring both to the SCCS office.

All other SJHS sports (Tennis (Girls), Cross Country (Girls and Boys, Junior High Swimming (Girls)

- Turn in registration at SCCS during Registration Week (August 9 – 13) or anytime until the sport begins.
- Forms required at registration are “Parent Permit Form”, the fee, an Independent Study Contract, and a Walking Release Form.
- To register you must have a 7th grade physical on file at SCCS.
- After the student turns in these forms and payment, made out to SCCS, he or she will receive a receipt to be given to the coach on the first day of practice.

Students who are invited to participate in Minnesota State High School League Varsity sports should contact the Stillwater Area High School Athletic Office for information about registering. These students should also complete an Independent Study Contract and, if it applies, a Walking Release Form for SCCS.

Football practice begins on August 30 and other sports begin on September 7. Also, watch for notices in your weekly FYI later in the year about registration for winter or spring sports.
