With the current unit on the home, the students have been learning sentence formation, both asking for and stating information about the house; several grammar points have been introduced, too. The fifth graders recently completed a drawing of a bedroom and composed a descriptive paragraph about it. The students are writing wonderful sentences in Spanish.

As the students continue to meet for Spanish class on Mondays and Thursdays, they need to be diligent in completing their homework, practicing Spanish each day outside of class (ten minutes daily is a suggested goal) and coming to class with **all** necessary materials (Spanish folder, completed assignment, writing tools, and flashcards). On the day assigned, please note that the Spanish assignments with directions are posted on PowerSchool. The last assessment for the house unit will be on March 24th; students will need to respond to questions and translate sentences using the bedroom vocabulary.

At the end of March, the fifth graders will continue their pursuit of the Spanish language as they begin an activities unit. They will be focusing on all four skill areas of speaking, listening, reading and writing in Spanish. *¡Qué divertido!*
